11 Point Checklist on

"Grabbing Your Audience's Attention in One Slide"

1. Start off with a Bang! - Create a sense of urgency for your audience.

2. <u>Show Don't Tell</u> - Show them the numbers. Your prospects are more interested in themselves and how they will benefit from whatever it is you're showing them.

3. <u>Define the Problem</u> - This is where you can really shine with animations and large text. Show your prospects how relevant the problem is to them.

4. <u>Offer a Solution</u> - Use language everyone can understand.

5. <u>Create a Plot Point</u> - Utilize your creativity. Make your audience the main character. Your story needs to be about the audience, not about you.

6. <u>Talk About Your Team</u> - These guys are important too! You can sell their skills and assets.

7. <u>Don't be Text Heavy</u> - Use graphs, charts and images over dull and plain black text. If your page is filled with words, the audience is likely not listening to you.

8. <u>Play to Your Audience's Interests</u> - Show your audience you care. They'll likely do the same.

9. <u>Use Big Fonts</u> - You don't have to be a graphic designer to communicate clearly. **You'll be good with a 24 - 32 point font.**

10. Use Awesome Quality Images - Don't let your PowerPoint content go to waste. Make sure your images pop.

11. **Incorporate Multimedia** - This offers a unique way to engage with your audience. **Play music!** Playing a simple and appropriate song in the background can make your audience feel more comfortable.

Bonus Tip!

Talk About Next Steps - NEVER end your presentation with "Questions?" Close with a call to action, so they know exactly what to do next.
